MINER FOOTBALL COACHING STAFF

TYLER FENWICK, HEAD FOOTBALL COACH

Coach Fenwick begins his sixth season in the fall of 2018, after leading the Miners to a 27-26 overall and 21-16 GLVC record in his first five seasons at the helm. Prior to arriving in Rolla, he had been part of a Missouri Western program Prior to that, he spent five years on the staff at Occidental College in California — the last four as offensive coordinator — and one season as offensive coordinator at Minnesota State University Moorhead, where the Dragons posted their first winning season in seven years. He began his coaching career at Birmingham High School in Lake Balboa, Calif., as the program's offensive coordinator, helping guide the team to a conference championship and playoff appearance as it finished with a 10-2 record.

MIKE BURTON, ASSISTANT FOOTBALL COACH

Coach Burton, a former quarterback at Missouri Western, serves as the Miners' wide receivers coach. He spent six seasons at MWSU working with the running backs during that period of time for an offensive unit that was headed by Coach Fenwick. He worked with Harlon Hill Award finalist Michael Hill over the last two seasons. As a player for the Griffons from 2003–06, Burton threw 3,151 yards passing and 10 touchdowns.

SHANE DOWTY, ASSISTANT FOOTBALL COACH

Coach Dowty spent two seasons as a GA at Iowa State. Prior to ISU, he spent two years at the College of the Desert (Calif.) and one year at Saint Ambrose in Iowa. He was also assistant at the University of Iowa during the 2009 and 2010 seasons working with the team's quarterbacks, including Ricky Stanzi, a fifth-round draft choice of the Kansas City Chiefs in 2011. Dowty, began his coaching career at the high school level as an assistant coach at Iowa City West High School.

ANDY BALL, ASSISTANT FOOTBALL COACH

Coach Ball, who spent four seasons as the Miners' offensive line coach and special teams coordinator from 2007–10, returns this season to Missouri S&T as the offensive coordinator. After the 2010 season, Ball joined Truman State as the defensive line coach and special teams coordinator for four years. Ball served as the offensive line coach at Missouri Western during the 2015 and 2016 seasons and coached six all-conference selections. Last year, Ball served as the head coach at St. Joseph Central High School where he mentored Bobby Lawrence, who signed to play at the University of Missouri.

TODD DRURY, ASSISTANT FOOTBALL COACH

Coach Drury, who serves as Defensive Line Coach, served as the D-Line coach and special teams coordinator as well as the strength coordinator at Evangel University for 2013–14 seasons. He was a graduate assistant for three years while working on his Master's degree in secondary education at Evangel. He was the linebackers coach and special teams coordinator at Midland Univ, in Nebraska during the 2012 season.

LOCATION AND FACILITIES

Missouri S&T Football Summer Prospect Camp will be held at the Allgood-Bailey Football Stadium and the Miner Dome behind the Gale Bullman Building, on the beautiful campus of Missouri S&T. These facilities are located on the corner of west 10th street and Highway 63/Bishop Road in Rolla, Missouri.

ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE

The Miner Football Prospect Camp will take place on Saturday, June 23, from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. So that the camp schedule can be maintained, it is very important that campers arrive by 9:45 a.m. and be picked up promptly at 1 p.m. All camp participants should be dropped off and picked up at the Allgood-Bailey Stadium.
