

Head Football Coach


Coach Fenwick begins his fifth season in the fall of 2017, after leading the Miners to a 20-23 overall and 16-14 GLVC record in his first four seasons at the helm. Prior to arriving in Rolla, he had been part of a Missouri Western program

that had played in the post-season in each of the six seasons that he was on the staff, including an appearance in the NCAA Division II quarterfinals in 2012.

Prior to that, he spent five years on the staff at Occidental College in California – the last four as offensive coordinator – and one season as offensive coordinator at Minnesota State University Moorhead, where the Dragons posted their first winning season in seven years.

He began his coaching career at Birmingham High School in Lake Balboa, Calif., as the program's offensive coordinator, helping guide the team to a conference championship and playoff appearance as it finished with a 10-2 record.

Campers will receive instruction and a Missouri S&T Football t-shirt for registration and participation in the camp.


We will accept campers all the way up until the start of camp. Walk-up campers can register starting at 9:45am on June 24th.
