MINER FOOTBALL COACHING STAFF

TODD DRURY HEAD FOOTBALL COACH

Todd Drury was named as the head football coach at Missouri S&T on January 11, 2019 after being with the program since 2015. Drury takes the helm of the program after guiding the Miner defense to the top of the GLVC over the last two years, as the defensive coordinator for three seasons.

MIKE BURTON ASSISTANT FOOTBALL COACH

Coach Burton, a former quarterback at Missouri Western, serves as the Miners' wide receivers coach. He spent six seasons at MWSU working with the running backs for an offensive unit that was headed by former S&T head coach Tyler Fenwick.

SHANE DOWTY ASSISTANT FOOTBALL COACH

Coach Dowty spent two seasons as a GA at Iowa State. Prior to ISU, he spent two years at the College of the Desert (Calif.) and one year at Saint Ambrose in Iowa. He was also assistant at the University of Iowa during the 2009 and 2010 seasons working with the team's quarterbacks, including Ricky Stanzi, a fifth-round draft choice of the Kansas City Chiefs in 2011.

ANDY BALL ASSISTANT FOOTBALL COACH

Coach Ball, who spent four seasons as the Miners' offensive line coach and special teams coordinator from 2007-10, returns as the offensive coordinator. After the 2010 season, Ball served in prominent roles at Truman State, Missouri Western, where he coached six all-conference selections, and St. Joseph Central High School where he mentored Bobby Lawrence, who signed to play at the University of Missouri.

DJ BLAND ASSISTANT FOOTBALL COACH

Coach Bland is beginning his second season on the Missouri S&T coaching staff as an assistant coach and begins his role as coach for the defensive backs, and in his first year on staff helped coach a unit that ranked at the top of the Great Lakes Valley Conference

DAMIEN ROSS ASSISTANT FOOTBALL COACH

Coach Ross joins as the team's wide receiver's coach after serving as head coach at Bangor High School in Michigan, three years at Midland University in Nebraska and a season as the wide receivers coach at MacMurray College in Jacksonville, Ill. Ross also spent the summer of 2016 as an educational coach with the Detroit Lions, teaching fundamentals and heads up tackling.



MINER FOOTBALL PROSPECT CAMP

The Miner Football Prospect Camp is for high school athletes that have an interest in college football and have a desire to be recruited by Missouri S&T or other universities. Emphasis will be placed on physical and skill evaluation.

Cost - \$45

EQUIPMENT NEEDED

All campers must provide their own shoes and mouthpiece. No other football equipment shall be worn during camp. Please make sure all personal property is properly marked by its owner. Missouri S&T Athletics and Miner Football is not responsible for the loss of personal property while at camp.

HEALTH DOCUMENTATION

Medical insurance is REQUIRED for all camp participants. Insurance company and policy numbers must be recorded online (see right) or on the Camper Registration form (see other side).

LOCATION AND FACILITIES

The Miner Football Prospect Camp will be held at the Allgood-Bailey Football Stadium on the beautiful Missouri S&T campus. These facilities are located on the corner of West 10th Street and Highway 63/Bishop Road in Rolla, Missouri.

ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE

The Miner Football Prospect Camp will take place on June 20 & 29, from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. So that the camp schedule can be maintained, it is very important that campers arrive by 9:45 a.m. and be picked up promptly at 1 p.m. All camp participants should be dropped off and picked up at the Allgood-Bailey Stadium.

ENROLLMENT

A full payment of \$45 per camper is required for all persons registering for the Miner Football Prospect Camp with their completed Registration Form (see Registration below). Fill out one form for each camper being registered.

Campers will receive instruction and a Missouri S&T Football T-shirt for registration and participation in the camp. We will accept campers all the way up until the start of camp. Walk-up campers can register starting at 9:45 a.m. the morning of each session.

CANCELLATIONS

The university reserves the right to cancel camp in the event of insufficient registrations, severe weather or natural disaster. In the event of cancellation, registrants will be notified immediately and all fees returned in full. Individuals wishing to cancel their registration must do so 5 days prior to the beginning date of the camp. Refunds will not be made after this date. Refunds will be minus \$15 administrative fee
